Failing prompt receipt of the amount requested the buyer's rights will be forfeited. As postal bids come to hand, lot numbers and bids will be noted in order of receipt and if identical bids are received, the bid that arrived first will take precedence.

It is the responsibility of all purchasers to obtain the necessary permits to procure before any restricted or registerable items can be uplifted. An Arms Officer will be in attendance at the auction and will be working in conjunction with our Licensed Firearms Dealer.

Postal bidders are advised that the parcels for successful bids are wrapped, and addressed during the WEEK after the auction. Costs are committed at this stage, in terms of Track Pack bags. Changing your instructions for delivery creates a great many problems and costs may be recovered from the buyer in these circumstances.

Ammunition & Firearms Purchases. Under the 1983 Arms Act, all postal purchases of firearms and ammunition must be approved by your local Arms Officer on the approved form (43a). The police will then forward the form to our Arms Dealer. Dangerous Goods provisions also apply to the transport of ammunition and powder and significant extra costs are involved (payable by you the purchaser) for any ammunition, or powder, forwarded as a postal bid.




